



Installation Guide MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro)

Installation and Getting started.

MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) is a complete Anti-Spam and Anti-Virus solution. This high speed, high performance, stable and secure content filtering solution provides out-of-the-box deployment.

System Requirement

MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) is packaged in simple to use three RPMs. It requires a Red Hat Linux 9 or higher to be installed on the system. The RPM requires 40 MB of free space.

- CommuniGate should already be installed and running on the system
- When you register the product, we make entries into the Main.settings file and Rules.settings files of CG Pro.

Getting MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) RPMs:

MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) is packaged in simple to use three RPMs.

- Web based Admin Module RPM - MWAdmin-1.0-X.i386.rpm
(Web based Admin Module is Common for all MicroWorld GNU/Linux Products)
- MicroWorld Anti-Virus Module RPM - mwav-1.0-X.i386.rpm
- MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) RPM - MailScan-CGPro-2.0-X.i386.rpm

Installation

To install the MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) use the following command as “root”

```
# rpm -ivh /path/to/rpm/MWAdmin-1.0-X.i386.rpm
# rpm -ivh /path/to/rpm/mwav-1.0-X.i386.rpm
# rpm -ivh /path/to/rpm/MailScan-CGPro-2.0-X.i386.rpm
```

This will install the complete package in it's own folder “/opt/MicroWorld”. The install process will also configure and start configuration and management application. Restart of CommuniGate after installing MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate) is not needed.

Configuration

To Configure MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) start a browser and go to:

```
https://<mail_server_ip>:10443/
```

e.g. if your server's IP is 192.168.0.1, URL will be

```
https://192.168.0.1:10443
```

- This will ask for an user name and password. Default user name and password is admin/admin.
- Before you can proceed to configure CGPro, you need to get a valid license key from MicroWorld web site. Follow the instructions provided on each screen.

Uninstallation

To remove MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) from the system you can use following command

```
# rpm -e MailScan-CGPro
```

- This will remove MailScan for Linux (CommuniGate Pro) from the system. However all changed configuration files, quarantined mails (Spam and infected) and mails in the queue will remain on the file systems.
- If any other MicroWorld GNU/Linux products are installed, MWAdmin is required package for them and you cannot uninstall this package
